

CREDENTIALING REQUIREMENTS FOR PHYSICIANS – MRI/CT

- PROVIDER REPRESENTS AND WARRANTS TO OCM THAT HE/SHE HAS ALL REQUISITE LICENSES AND CERTIFICATIONS FROM THE STATE IN WHICH THE PROVIDER IS RENDERING SERVICE. PROVIDER ALSO SATISFIES ALL APPLICABLE STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS THAT PERTAIN TO HIS/HER FIELD OF MEDICINE.
- COMPLETED AND SIGNED APPLICATION
- SIGNED OCM ATTESTATION PAGE
- CURRENT CURRICULUM VITAE – WHICH INCLUDES COMPLETE EDUCATION AND WORK HISTORY (INCLUDE ANY EXPLANATION OF GAPS)
- CURRENT, UNRESTRICTED MEDICAL LICENSE IN THE STATE IN WHICH HE/SHE PRACTICES
- BOARD CERTIFICATION IN RADIOLOGY OR DIAGNOSTIC RADIOLOGY FROM THE AMERICAN BOARD OF RADIOLOGY.
OR
COMPLETION OF AN ACCREDITED DIAGNOSTIC RADIOLOGY RESIDENCY PROGRAM IN THE UNITED STATES AND 150 HOURS OF RELEVANT CATEGORY I CME’S** IN THE PAST 36 MONTHS
OR
COMPLETION OF AN ACCREDITED RESIDENCY IN THE SPECIALTY PRACTICED IN THE UNITED STATES, 150 HOURS OF RELEVANT CATEGORY I CME’S** AND 500 MRI EXAMINATIONS IN THE PAST 36 MONTHS
OR
THE AMERICAN OSTEOPATHIC BOARD OF RADIOLOGY CERTIFICATE WILL BE REVIEWED ON A CASE BY CASE BASIS.
- CURRENT, UNRESTRICTED FEDERAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION (DEA) CERTIFICATE (IF APPLICABLE)
- CURRENT, UNRESTRICTED STATE CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE (CDS) CERTIFICATE, WHERE REQUIRED
- CURRENT PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE WITH SUFFICIENT COVERAGE AMOUNTS OF \$1M/\$3M OR AS REQUIRED BY LAW IN THE PHYSICIAN’S PRIMARY STATE
- PHYSICIAN MUST REPORT DETAILS OF ALL MALPRACTICE CLAIMS FILED AGAINST HIM/HER FOR THE LAST 5 YEARS, REGARDLESS OF OUTCOME. THE NATURE OF MALPRACTICE CLAIMS MAY BE THE BASIS FOR DENIAL OF APPLICATION BY THE CREDENTIALING COMMITTEE
- PHYSICIAN MUST HAVE A VALID WORKERS COMPENSATION CERTIFICATE FOR THOSE STATES THAT REQUIRE SUCH CERTIFICATION
- PHYSICIAN MUST HAVE NO HISTORY OF MEDICARE/MEDICAID SANCTION ACTIVITY
- EDUCATION COMMISSION FOR FOREIGN MEDICAL GRADUATES (ECFMG) CERTIFICATE (IF APPLICABLE)

*EFFECTIVE 7/20/2011, OCM WILL REVIEW PHYSICIANS WITH AN AMERICAN OSTEOPATHIC BOARD OF RADIOLOGY CERTIFICATE ON A CASE BY CASE BASIS.

** CME MUST BE SUBJECT RELEVANT TO WORKER’S COMP MRI & CT PROCEDURES. DATE OF COMPLETION IS CONSIDERED WHEN ACCOUNTING FOR 36 MONTHS (NOT DATE AWARDED)
