



OCM CREDENTIALING REQUIREMENTS FOR PHYSICIANS - EMG

- COMPLETED AND SIGNED APPLICATION
- SIGNED OCM ATTESTATION PAGE.
- CURRENT CURRICULUM VITAE – WHICH INCLUDES COMPLETE EDUCATION AND WORK HISTORY (INCLUDE ANY EXPLANATION OF GAPS)
- BOARD CERTIFICATION IN NEUROLOGY OR PHYSICAL MEDICINE & REHABILITATION
OR
COMPLETION OF AN ACCREDITED RESIDENCY PROGRAM SPECIALIZING IN NEUROLOGY OR PHYSICAL MEDICINE & REHABILITATION
- CURRENT, UNRESTRICTED MEDICAL LICENSE IN THE STATE IN WHICH HE/SHE PRACTICES
- PHYSICIAN MUST HAVE CURRENT, UNRESTRICTED FEDERAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION (DEA) CERTIFICATE
- PHYSICIAN MUST HAVE CURRENT, UNRESTRICTED STATE CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE (CDS) CERTIFICATE, WHERE REQUIRED
- PHYSICIAN MUST HAVE CURRENT PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE WITH SUFFICIENT COVERAGE AMOUNTS OF \$1M/\$3M OR AS REQUIRED BY LAW IN THE PHYSICIAN’S PRIMARY STATE.
- PHYSICIAN MUST HAVE NO HISTORY OF MEDICARE/MEDICAID SANCTION ACTIVITY, WHEN APPLICABLE.
- PHYSICIAN MUST REPORT DETAILS OF ALL MALPRACTICE CLAIMS FILED AGAINST HIM/HER FOR THE LAST 5 YEARS, REGARDLESS OF OUTCOME. THE NATURE OF MALPRACTICE CLAIMS MAY BE THE BASIS FOR DENIAL OF APPLICATION BY THE CREDENTIALING COMMITTEE.
- PHYSICIAN MUST HAVE A VALID WORKERS COMPENSATION CERTIFICATE FOR THOSE STATES THAT REQUIRE SUCH CERTIFICATION.
- EDUCATION COMMISSION FOR FOREIGN MEDICAL GRADUATES (ECFMG) CERTIFICATE (IF APPLICABLE)
- SUBMIT 3 ABNORMAL EMG REPORTS TO CLINICAL SERVICES FOR REVIEW
